IN HONOUR OF

Edward Cecil Guinness born in Dublin in 1847 was the third son of Sir Benjamin Guinness and younger brother of Arthur Guinness.

In 1873 he married Adelaide Guinness, nicknamed "Dodo" who was descended from the banking line of Guinness's. Their principal town residence was Iveagh House on St. Stephen's Green where they entertained and were renowned for throwing famous Masquerade Balls in their lavish ballroom.

Edward was chief executive of the Guinness Brewing Company and became the chairman of the board, running the largest brewery in the world. By the age of 29 he had taken over the Dublin brewery after buying out the half share from his older brother Arthur. He brought unprecedented success to St James's Gate, multiplying the value of the brewery. Edward Cecil Guinness' success was recognised and he became the 1st Earl of Iveagh.

Edward was a generous philanthropist and established the Guinness Trust, later called the Iveagh Trust. This still administers a large foundation in the name of the Guinness family and provides housing and amenities for the poorer people of Dublin city.

The Earl of Iveagh's legacy is still intact in Dublin to this day. Many of these striking red-brick buildings with their distinctive "Iveagh" branded logo can be seen around Dublin City which we call the Iveagh Trail.
